The Recreation Center has plenty of healthy offerings for all budgets. The Fitness Room was expanded in October 2008 and now has double the treadmills, elliptical trainers, and stationary bicycles (all Precor). A bicep/tricep and inner/outer thigh machine have been added, as well as a Smith Press and additional dumbbells. The Fitness Room is open during regular business hours (see sidebar). Memberships are available for residents and non-residents at yearly and monthly rates, as well as a special Senior Rate (over 60) and family memberships. Please bring your Haltom Recreation ID with you each time you visit. Proof of residency is required for membership.

Endless Opportunities for the Kids!

Haltom City Parks and Recreation has plenty to keep the kids active this summer:

- **7-on-7 Football**—Get your team ready for some football! This is the first season of 7-on-7 and the only league like it in the Metroplex! Leagues will be 12 & under and 14 & under. Cost is \$300/team. Registration deadline is May 23. Each team must have at least one coach.
- **Blast Ball**—For the younger bunch! Boys and girls ages 3 to 6 years, can learn the basic fundamentals of t-ball, with the use of a “honking” base! Tons of fun for the whole family! Cost is \$30/player and includes a shirt. Registration deadline is May 30. Coaches are needed!
- **Girls' Volleyball League**—Dig this, girls only! Girls ages 12-17 can register individually for \$20/player or bring their own team for \$120/team. All teams must have a coach. Registration deadline is May 30. Coaches are needed!
- **Haltom Heat Baseball Camp**—Learn great skills from Coach Bourland, Baseball coach at Haltom High School. Camp Dates: Ages 5 to 8—July 13-16 from 8 to 11am, Ages 9 to 12—July 20-23 from 8 to 11am. Cost is \$30/Residents and \$40/Non-Residents and includes a camp shirt. Registration deadlines: July 10 for Camp I and July 17 for Camp II.
- **Hot Shots Basketball Camp**—Learn great skills from Coach Bacon, Basketball Coach at Richland High School. Camp dates: Ages 7 to 12—June 22-25 from 9am to 12pm, Ages 13 to 17—June 22-25 from 1 to 4pm. Cost is \$35/Residents and \$45/Non-Residents and includes a camp shirt. Registration deadline is June 19.
- **Summer Youth Basketball League**—we're joining forces with Haltom High School's Basketball Department to put on our first ever Summer Basketball league! Boys and girls in the 1st—8th grade can register through May 30. Season will begin mid-June. Cost is \$50/Residents and \$60/Non-Residents and includes a uniform shirt, water bottle, and individual award. Coaches are needed!
- **Track**—Boys and girls ages 6 to 18 can participate in the TAAF Summer Track program. Practices will be held during the week, with local meets being held on Saturdays. Participants can advance to Regional and State Track meets. Cost is \$35/Residents and \$45/Non-Residents and includes a shirt. Registration deadline is May 23.
